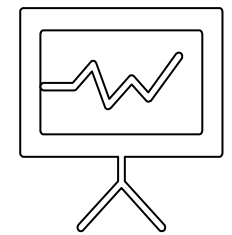

Bias and disadvantage concerning diverse populations

Data and design bias

- *Selection bias* → the selection of individuals or groups is not representative of the (diverse) population (e.g. undocumented migrants, transient populations, new arrivals, ...).
- *Disadvantage/presence bias* → the presence of individuals or groups in administrative datasets regarding social provision is affected by the individual or group's social condition or status.
- *Allocation bias* → there is a systematic difference in how different populations are allocated social services depending on legal status and individual/group profiles/contexts.
